

Old Mill Holiday Park

Site Accessibility Statement

THE SITE

Our site is a small family run holiday park which is situated overlooking Bembridge harbour in the rural location of St Helens. The park is split into two levels by Mill Road, a small lane which is a no through road. The lower level caravans nos. 1 to 16 are on level ground and are approached by a paved footpath. Vehicles are not permitted in the park but the car park is adjacent and on the same level. The park facilities and reception are approximately fifty metres away access to which is along the lane which slopes upwards. The upper park is a sloping site on which caravans nos. 20 to 34 are situated along with the pine cabins 17, 18, 35, 36 and the Lodge. The Glade apartments are also situated on the upper park and have parking spaces adjacent approached from Latimer Road. Vehicles are not permitted on the upper site which has a car park sited at its top end. Most caravans are accessible by a downward sloping paved pathway; however caravans 28 to 34 are accessed by steps from this pathway. There is a lay-by adjacent to the paved footpath which fronts onto Mill Road and gives level access to these units; parking is not normally permitted in this lay-by.

THE ACCOMMODATION

Most of our caravans and cabins have steps up to the front door. The exceptions are caravans 1, 2, 3 and 4 and cabins 19, 35 and The Lodge. These units have balconies which are accessed by ramps of a reasonable gradient. The Glade apartments have steps to the front door and the first floor is only accessible via the staircase. Caravan no. 1 is particularly suitable for disabled guests with level access from the footpath and allocated disabled parking adjacent to the unit.

RECEPTION

Our reception is situated adjacent to Mill Road with limited parking on the forecourt. The entrance is approached via a paved walkway with an upward gradient. Reception is normally open from 8.30 to 17.00 Monday to Saturday. There is an out of hours number displayed on the door and a member of staff is usually available on site when the reception is closed.

GAMES ROOM

The entrance to the Games Room is adjacent to Reception and has double door access without steps.

LAUNDRY ROOM

The laundry is located across the driveway from Reception and has single door access of standard width. Access from the upper park is via a downward slope and from the lower park an upward slope. These gradients are quite steep.

SITE LOCATION

The Old Mill Holiday Park is situated in a rural location within a few minutes walk of the village centre via a small road which slopes upward from the site. Facilities in the village include two restaurants, a newsagents, corner shop/post office and public house. The lower park fronts onto Bembridge Harbour but beaches are a walk of some 20 minutes away.

TRANSPORT

Public transport is available from Ryde on the No. 14 bus service which is an hourly service through the day, and an hourly service during the evening. The service continues to Bembridge and stops at Tesco's superstore. There is also the No. 10 bus service from Newport which is an hourly service until mid evening.

The above information is a brief description of the site's accessibility. We would suggest that a phone call to the site would be advantageous so that staff can assess individual requirements and assist in any way possible.
